- create a space for people interested in international issues to come and learn with and from each other.

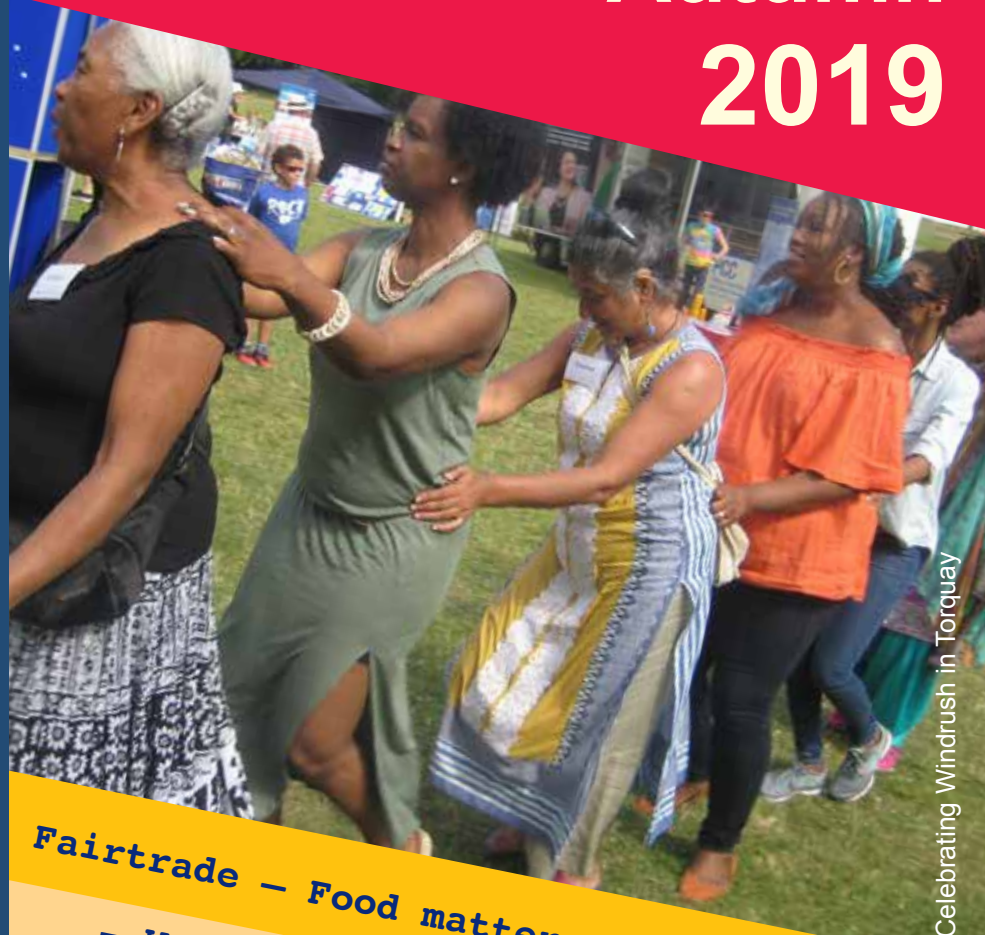
