

DDE volunteer opportunity: Fundraising Leader

Devon Development Education are seeking a volunteer to act as our fundraising leader, working with the Coordinator to ensure that we have the necessary funds to maintain and develop our activities. DDE works with schools and the general public across Devon, Plymouth and Torbay. We provide events, activities and resources which enable local people to learn more about the lives of people in other parts of the world, encouraging us all to become global citizens. As a charity with no core funding, we rely on fundraising to carry out our projects and to cover our basic running costs for the office and staff salaries.

Key tasks

- Take a lead on fundraising at DDE.
- Monitor the funding environment and maintain awareness of grant for which DDE could apply.
- Liaise with the DDE coordinator to link project ideas to possible funding opportunities.
- Work with DDE staff and volunteers to write grant applications and hold fundraising events and activities.

Time required

This can be flexible, to fit around other activities and commitments. It is likely to need more time in some periods than others, for example to write a grant application or run an activity.

Essential:

- Experience of writing successful grant applications.
- Commitment to DDE's aims and values, including the importance of education for all and an inclusive and open society.

Desirable:

- Knowledge of the education system in England.
