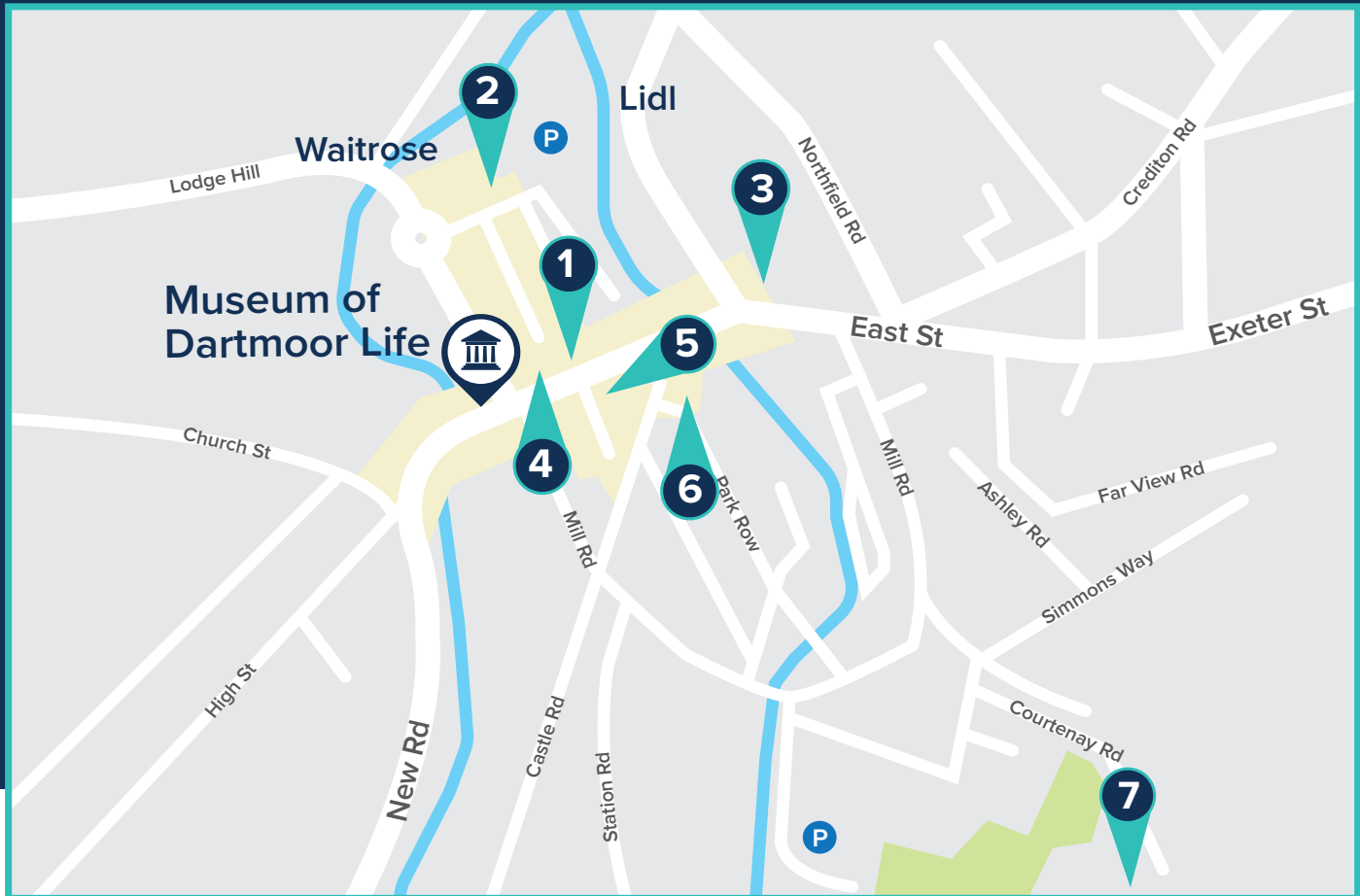


Town Centre Exhibition Trail
