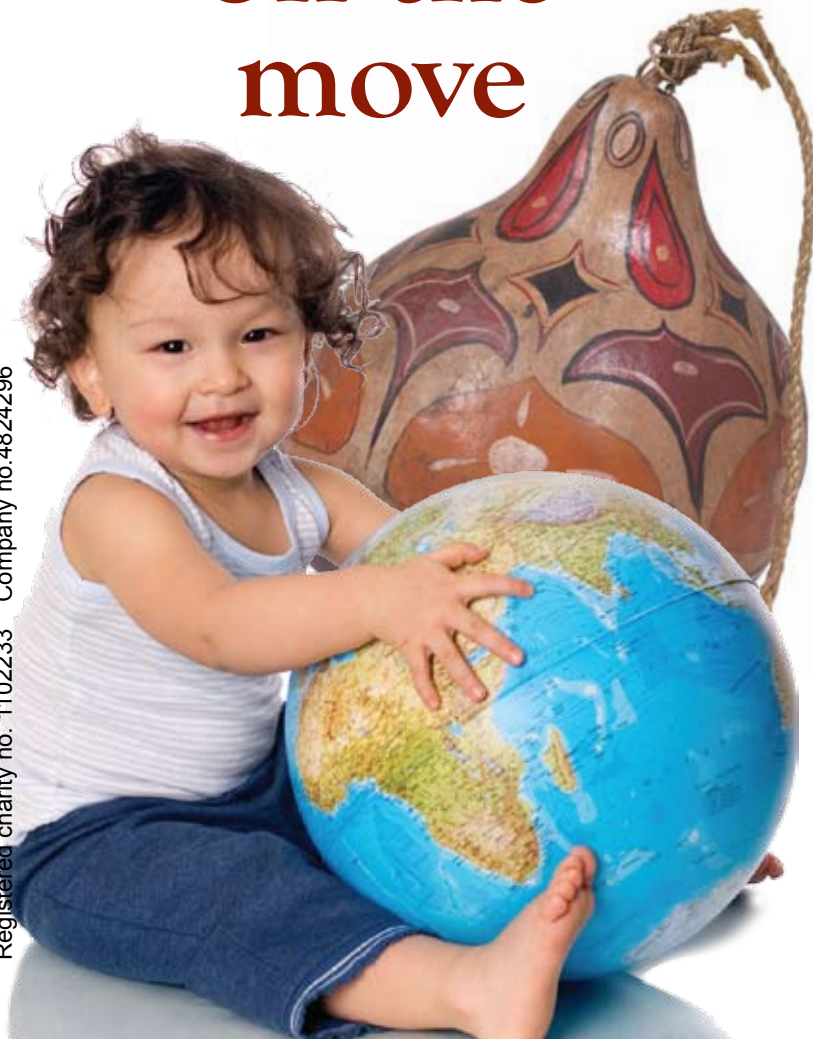


# Calabash on the move
